

The morning after usually leaves questions unanswered where its mission has been changed, lost or never found. Every day we traverse and organise spaces, select them and connect them with each other. Sentences and itineraries, spatial curves and manuals are created. Movements and their changes are regulated by means of a whole series of codes, organised procedures and constraints. *Tomorrow and tomorrow and tomorrow again* is a tacit request to go beyond the familiar in order to create a mode of reliability within everyday routines.

From here it goes there; this place includes, excludes, another space, a dream or a memory. The choreography is clear, and the recipe is cooked again, and again, and again, the copy of the copy of the copy in endless playback. This is how we approach the kitchen. An ellipse of reflection in stainless steel. The kitchen as a place determined by units of measurement and norms as well as by intuition, desire and association. Its interior as a mixture of social and architectural relationships, workplace, mock-ups, intimate sphere, enclosure, expertise, command centre and control room, self-presentation and TV stars. Often friendships begin in kitchens. Different rules apply here - physical, mathematical and social rules. The more professionalised the kitchen, the shorter the distances. Smaller contact surface places importance on the topping. The caviar/blini ratio is unstable. In this exhibition, the kitchen, presents itself to us as a backdrop and protagonist, in search of other forms of perception and a knowledge that is reflected in the bodies, creatures and objects of our everyday environment.
