Between abstraction, onirism and critical realism, Alain Séchas intrigues and pushes the viewer to confront, to question his position, while offering us a humouristic reflection on daily life.

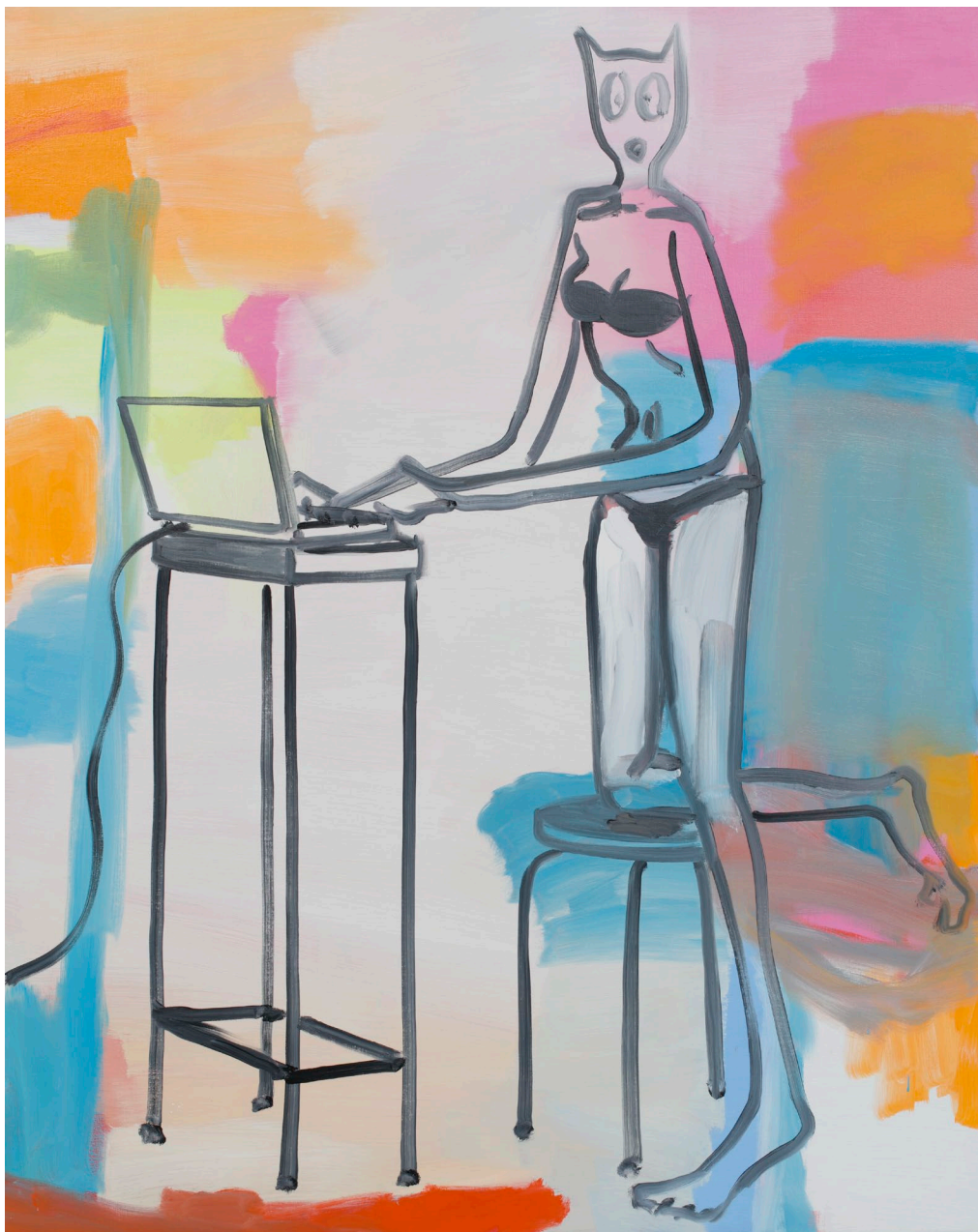

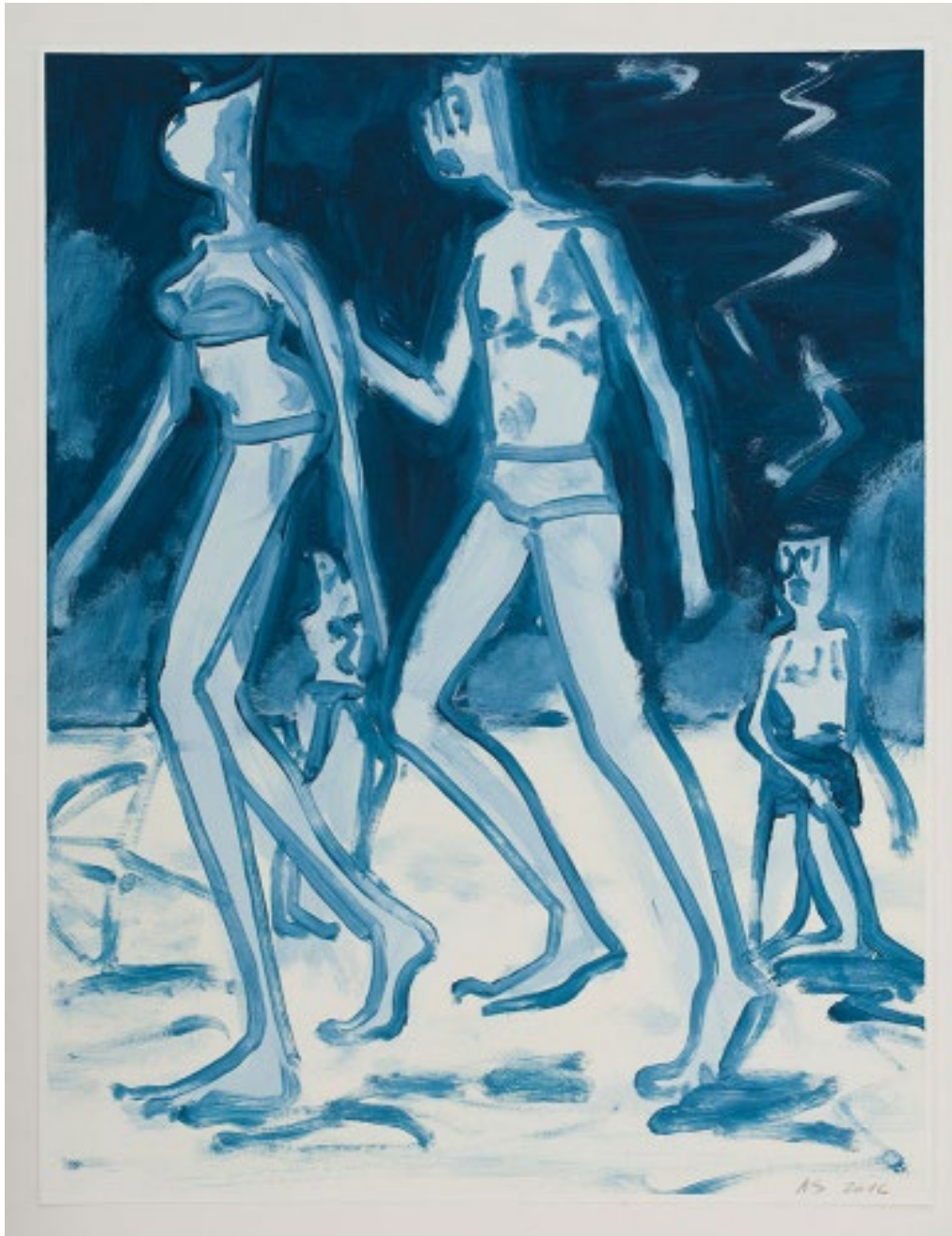

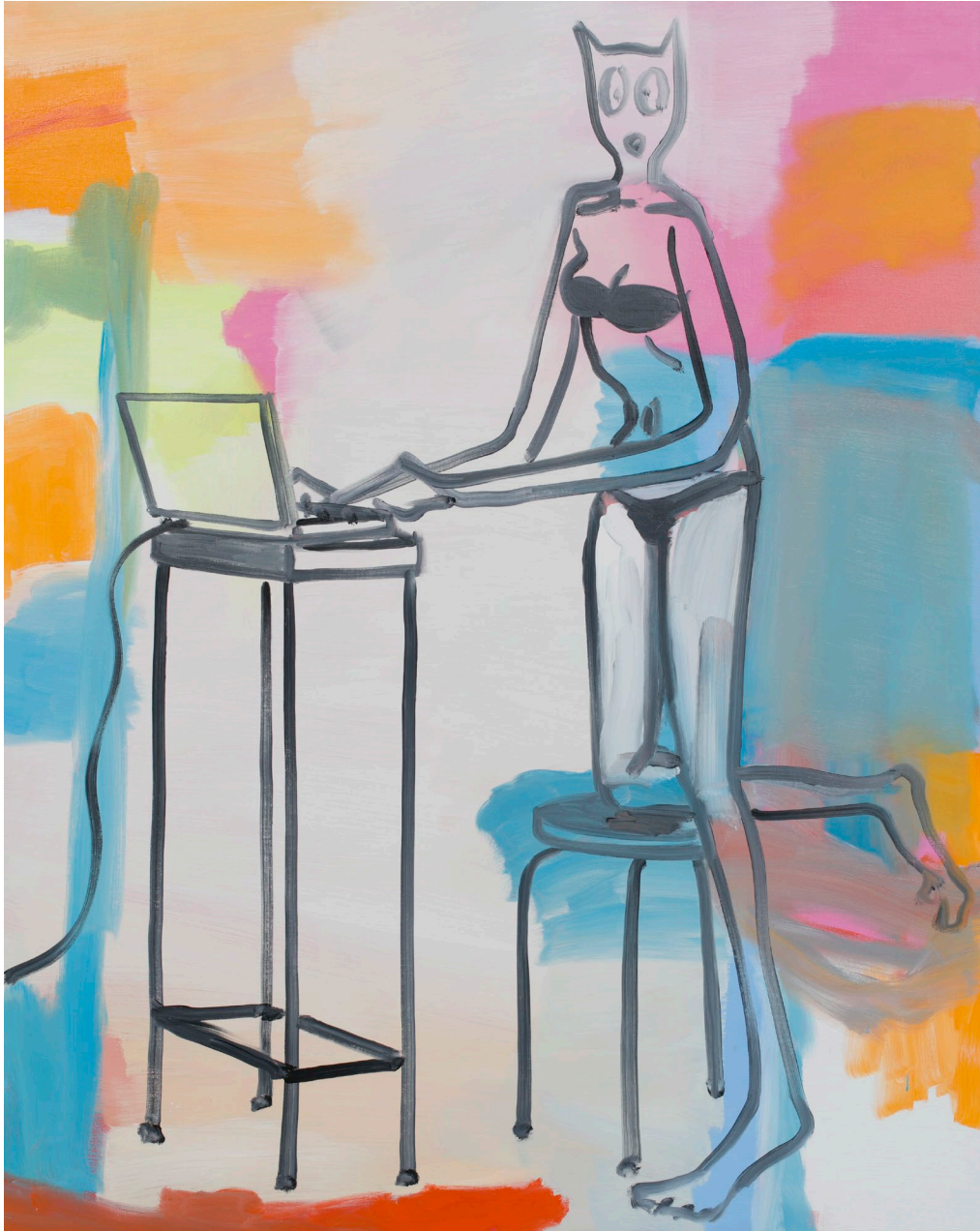
